



# Fang Hui Yuan (芳晖苑)

As far as antiques from the Ming and Qing dynasties go, the porcelain items here are really gorgeous and unique. The shop owner is an avid collector of antiques, and she told me how to distinguish authentic items from fakes.

<p>This is a jade decoration with traditional Chinese patterns. See the dragon in the middle? Dragons were once used to symbolize the emperor.</p>	
<p>This is a jade ring that is almost 1,000 years old!</p>	

This fantastic blue-and-white porcelain plate has flowers arranged in a very auspicious design.



Like most antique porcelain, the potter signed his name and date on the bottom of this bowl. This one was made in the Ming dynasty for the imperial court.



This jar is the shop owner's favorite item. Look at its shape: it is very difficult to craft.



Jade rings are often seen at burial sites. This ring is so delicate, and I like its color very much.



I have never seen such beautiful items in other shops. Look at the fresh green color and the exquisite patterns!
